How do I get started??

Once you have decided you want to host/participate in a “Volley For The Cure” event, you first need to:

1. Find a team(s) to partner with you and “Volley For The Cure”. This can be a team within the normal district/conference you normally play or be a team you would not normally play. The match can be either between two teams or could be a tri-match. The more people you get involved the better!
2. Pick a date that works for all the teams involved- the sooner the better as school sport schedules are usually jam packed.
3. Find a person willing to organize your event- this may or may not be you. Some events have parents, coaches or school clubs/teams that organize the event. There is no “right” way; anyone who is enthusiastic about the cause and has a little organizational skill can pull this off!
4. Go to www.harcoboe.com and look for the “Volley For The Cure” logo. I have lots of sample forms so you don’t have to “reinvent the wheel”. Most of the forms have “insert your school name here” areas to make it as easy as possible. I suggest you go to the web site and print out one of each and read them over.
