Involving the entire volleyball program

- If possible, have all of the teams (junior high through junior varsity) wear Volley for the Cure uniforms on a designated day.
- Try to get all of the teams in your program to wear pink on the day of the event.
- Fundraising ideas for middle school teams may include bake sales or getting pledges for serves or digs.
- Sell Basket Raffle Tickets and t-shirts prior to event and day of event.

Involving other school groups

- Invite the band, drum line or pep band to provide pre-match and between match entertainment.
- Ask the choral group to sing the National Anthem.
- Invite the American Sign Language class to sign the National Anthem.
- Ask the Student Government or Pep Club to organize a Spirit bus if it is an “away” match.
- Invite the health teachers to share educational materials and models.
- Have team captains from both teams work together to plan event.
- Help educate by presenting quick facts during school announcements.

Involving the Community

- Invite the entire community to the event.
- Ask the local Komen affiliate to help you get the word out to area.
- Invite breast cancer survivors/families to attend the event and offer free admittance. Have a special raffle for survivors.
- Have the officials wear a pink top &/or pink whistle.
- During the match have the announcer present quick facts about breast cancer.
- Observe a moment of silence at the game for breast cancer survivors & their families.
