Educating the school

1. Have a table set up at lunches/before school with educational materials.
2. Present quick facts about breast cancer during the week of the event on school announcements.
3. Ask the health classes to teach their breast cancer unit during the week of the event/mention the event during class.
4. Bring in a guest speaker for special "Girls only" assemblies about breast cancer awareness & self-breast exams.

Educating the community at the event

1. Have a table set up at in a prominent location with educational materials or put together information bags to give all the women at the event.
2. Have the announcer present quick facts about breast cancer during the match.
3. Invite your local WV Cervical & Breast Cancer Screening Program representative to give out information at the event.
4. Invite your local media to attend the event to raise awareness.

Honor Breast Cancer Survivors and families who have been affected by Breast Cancer

1. Observe a moment of silence at the event for Breast Cancer Survivors and families who have been affected by Breast Cancer.
2. Have a special raffle for survivors & bring them onto the floor to recognize them and possibly give them a pink rose/Carnation. Try to involve your local florist. You could also give survivors something special such as a survivor hat- be creative!
