

[Quaker Snack Mix Baked Cheddar Voluntarily Recalled Due to Possible Health Risk](#)

Quaker Snack Mix Baked Cheddar is being voluntarily recalled after Basic Food Flavors, Inc. of Las Vegas, Nevada initiated a recall of their hydrolyzed vegetable protein (HVP) due to potential Salmonella contamination. HVP is a very minor ingredient in the seasoning for this product. Although every seasoning lot tested negative for Salmonella, and there are no reports of Salmonella-related illness related to this product, the product is voluntarily being recalled out of an abundance of caution.
