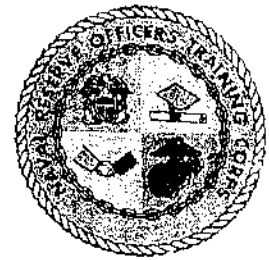

DIRECTIONS FOR COMPLETING YOUR NROTC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

1. Complete your Online Application. Log on to our website at <https://www.nrotc.navy.mil> (don't forget the "s" after http). Go to "Fill out an Application" and complete your Online Application. Be thorough and check your work before you hit "Submit".
2. SAT/ACT Scores. If you have not already released your qualifying SAT or ACT scores to the Navy Scholarship Program (Code 0656), you must ensure the scores are recorded in your official transcript.
3. Teacher Evaluations. Once I receive your Online Application, I will send these forms to you. If you are applying for the Regular Four Year Scholarship, you will require the following evaluations:
 - Guidance Counselor - "Request for Secondary School Transcript". Ensure Official Transcript and school profile are attached.
 - Math Teacher - "Math Teacher Evaluation" completed by your Junior (preferable) or Sophomore Math Teacher.
 - English Teacher - "English Teacher Evaluation" completed by your Junior (preferable) or Sophomore English Teacher.
 - Other Official - "Other Official Evaluation" completed by another Teacher, Coach, or Employer of your choice.

NURSE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS ONLY:

 - Science Teacher - Instead of the "Math Teacher Evaluation", submit an "Other Official Evaluation" completed by your Junior (preferable) or Sophomore Science Teacher.
4. Submission of Teacher Evaluations. These forms must be completed and returned to my office at the address at the top of this form as soon as possible.
5. Interview. Once I receive all of the above, I will contact you to schedule your interview.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Ensure all Teacher Evaluations are filled out completely, signed, dated, and have written comments included or attached.
- Ensure YOU fill out and sign the top section of the "Request for Secondary School Transcript" before giving it to your Guidance Counselor.
- It is your responsibility to ensure your Evaluations are returned to me expediently.
- Your Official Transcript must include complete grades from 9th, 10th, and 11th grade. Applicants still in their junior year may schedule their interview with Official Transcript from 9th & 10th grade and current 11th grade report card.
- You will receive a Strong Interest Inventory in the mail. You must complete this form and bring it with you to your interview.
- Interviews will not be scheduled until all evaluations have been received.
- Ensure that you apply to all of your selected schools before their application deadline.

To All RINCs and Recruiters,

As many of you know I am the MM1(SS) Lazeski, the Advanced Programs Coordinator and NROTC Coordinator for NRD Pittsburgh. What most of you do not know is that ROTC Scholarships are now part of EPO. With this change I am asking for your continued support in referring candidates who qualify for ROTC to me. Included with this letter is more detailed information so that you can sell this program better.

The ROTC program across the nation is struggling this year to make goal and has become a priority for CNRC, but thanks to your help, NRD Pittsburgh is doing well so far this year and with your continued support I know we can exceed our goals for this year. For recruiter competition purposes, ROTC applications will count towards awards such as recruiter of the year. For this reason if you talk to someone about ROTC, be sure to give me his/her information so that I can credit the individual recruiter.

If you have an applicant with good SAT scores, or if you have a depper with good SAT scores who would like a chance at this opportunity, try and get them to apply for an ROTC scholarship. Here are some basic facts on the program:

1. Applicants must complete the online NROTC Scholarship Application prior to 5 February 2006: <https://www.nrotc.navy.mil>
2. Applicants must meet minimum SAT or ACT score criteria of:
 - ☐ SAT: Math 520 / Critical Reading (Verbal) 530 or
 - ☐ ACT: Math 22 / English 22

The new SATs have an extra section for critical writing. If you subtract out the critical writing score it is equivalent to what they would have got on the new SATs.

3. Medical disqualification for an enlisted program does not prevent someone from completing an application; only DOD physical can disqualify someone. So even if they wouldn't qualify for you to process them, they can still complete an ROTC application.
4. Navy Nursing is a separate ROTC program in which we need applications for this year. If you have any HM deppers with good SAT score, have them put in an application to maximize their opportunities in the Navy. If they get selected for a scholarship, they do not count against you as an attrite, they are taken at the region level.

Anyone who wants to apply for ROTC, complete the following steps;

1. Record applicants name, phone number, address, high school, year of graduation, and SAT scores and fax it to me at (412) 395- 5404.
2. Refer them to the website: <https://www.nrotc.navy.mil>, or have them go to www.navy.com and click on the ROTC banner. This is where they begin their online application, and I receive all the info they put into the website.
3. If the have any questions while they are in your office that you can not answer, call me at (412) 395-5880 or my cell (724) 244-8462 and I would be happy to speak with the applicant.

In the future I will be coming out to your stations to help you achieve your Nuke goal when you get one. I look forward to working with all of you and greatly appreciate your

help in this matter. Whatever I can do to help support your mission, please contact me, I would be happy to arrange some time in my schedule to help you out. I am now working for ETCS(SW) Walker, who is the Fusion Cell Director, and will be in charge of Advanced Programs, Leads, and DEP management, so you can contact him for support as well. Thank you all for your help.
