 - library books and supplies

 - duplication services;
- ♦ funds for school buses and maintenance vehicles; and
- ♦ funds to maintain staffing, provide extracurricular supplemental pay, and supplements and benefits for all Harrison County School employees.

Policy 3102 Equal Opportunity Employment Statement of Purpose

The Harrison County Board of Education shall extend equal employment opportunities to all qualified persons in all occupations and at all levels of occupation without regard to sex, race, handicap, religion, color, national origin, and ancestry. The Harrison County Board of Education shall not discriminate against nor grant preferential treatment to any person on account of that person's sex, race, handicap, religion, color, national origin, or ancestry. All employment policies and practices, including salaries, hiring, promotion, transfer and fringe benefits of employment, shall be provided without discrimination or preferential treatment on any of the aforementioned bases.

LEVY CALL PROPOSAL

Continue to provide **free textbooks and teaching supplies** for all schools.

4th grade texts cost \$460/student,
7th grade texts cost \$565/student,
10th grade texts cost \$681/student

Each school will receive an allotment of \$30 per pupil for teaching supplies, plus additional funds for family and consumer science, vocational agriculture, and technology education.

Increase allowances for **technology** such as computers, wiring, hardware and software, staff training, and personnel. It will also assist classroom teachers with using technology and will provide necessary training and professional development. It will assist schools in obtaining computer repairs. A direct allocation of \$25 per pupil goes to each school for technology.

Increase the annual **allowance for transportation** support for academic and athletic activities. High schools will be allocated \$11,000 plus \$3 per student. Middle schools will be allocated \$4,500 plus \$3 per student,

and elementary schools will be allocated \$3,000 plus \$2 per student enrolled.

A **new** item will provide funds to permit all Harrison County middle and high school students **free admission to all regular county sporting events** with proper student identification. It will also provide for Harrison County residents **60 years and older free admission** to all regular county sporting events with a school issued pass.

Another **new** item will allocate \$5,000 annually to each middle school to provide **supplemental supplies and equipment for athletic programs**.

Increase allowances for **band, music and theater** which are allocated directly to the schools for expenditure.

Increase funds to improve, renovate, and construct **high school athletic facilities**. Each high school will receive approximately \$60,000 per year to be used on athletic facilities.

Provide **student accident insurance** for all students enrolled in Harrison County Schools.

Increase allowances for maintenance, renovation, and new construction for all **school facilities** as needed. Funds may be used to help match other grant funds, such as the School Building Authority.

Increase allowances to provide funds for the United Technical Center for **vocational education** classes for high school students.

Provide funds for **library** books and supplies, **science** supplies, **special education** supplies, **speech and guidance** supplies, **physical education** supplies, **art** supplies, and **duplication** services which are directly allocated to all schools.

Provide additional funds for school **buses** and maintenance vehicles.

Increase funds to maintain **staffing** levels that exceed the basic state allowance, provide for all **extracurricular supplemental pay** (including academic, band/music, and coaching), and **supplements and benefits** for all Harrison County School employees.
