Subject: Schedule of Proposed Levy Rates

Each county board is required to hold a meeting or meetings to ascertain the fiscal condition of the board and determine the amount to be raised by the levy of taxes. The session is to then stand adjourned until the third Tuesday in April (April 14, 2009). We have not received the regular levy amounts that are set by the legislature; however, we do not expect them to change from the previous year. The current rates are listed below.

The total amount that is deducted from the current expense levy is \$286,099 for Tax Incremental Financing (TIF). The board will receive this amount through the state aid formula local share calculation rather than regular levy tax collections. The TIF projects do not affect the excess levy amounts collected.

As you may recall, the excess levy call stipulates a 104% rollback provision which excludes appraisal or valuation due to new construction or improvements to existing real property, including beginning recovery of natural resources and newly acquired personal property. The excess levy rates do not reflect a rollback from the prior year rates and are set at the rate which was included in the original levy order. The current rates are listed below.

The attached Schedule of Proposed Levy Rates indicates amounts raised by the 2009-10 levy rates as follows:
